1. Welcome:

2. Banking Statements:

- We have received three new Sponsors for the Bulldog foundation including Oregon Pacific Construction, Hallmark Properties, and Woodburn Pet hospital.
- We paid out just over \$1300 for new apparel.

3. Bulldog Clothing:

- New apparel has been ordered and received. Doug will work on adding them to the website for people to purchase. We will also have them available to sell at registration next week.
- We have mens and womans sweatshirts in cotton and dri-fit, and well as shirts.

4. Foundation Audit:

- Doug and Rocio are working on an audit of our financials as required in the by-laws.

5. Concessions:

- We will be teaming up with Volleyball for the varsity game on 9/13, and they have agreed to help us with the 50/50 raffle that night. Volleyball will receive half of the concessions proceeds for that night, and the Bulldog Foundation will received 100% of the 50/50 proceeds.
- Varsity concessions are 9/13, 10/4 (homecoming) and 10/18 (Senior night)
- JV Concessions 9/23, 9/30 and 10/14.

- Doug will have his laptop available for people to sign up, as well as the ipad for payments and purchases.
